BE GENTLE AND KIND

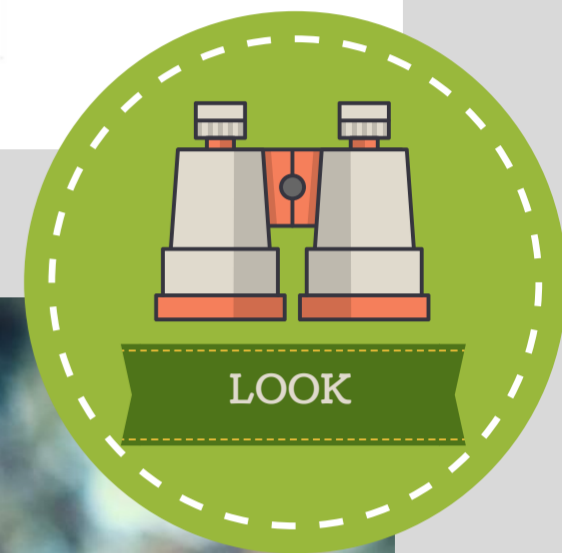
Respect Kangaroo rest areas beyond the barriers

Observe and notice the differences between types of Roos



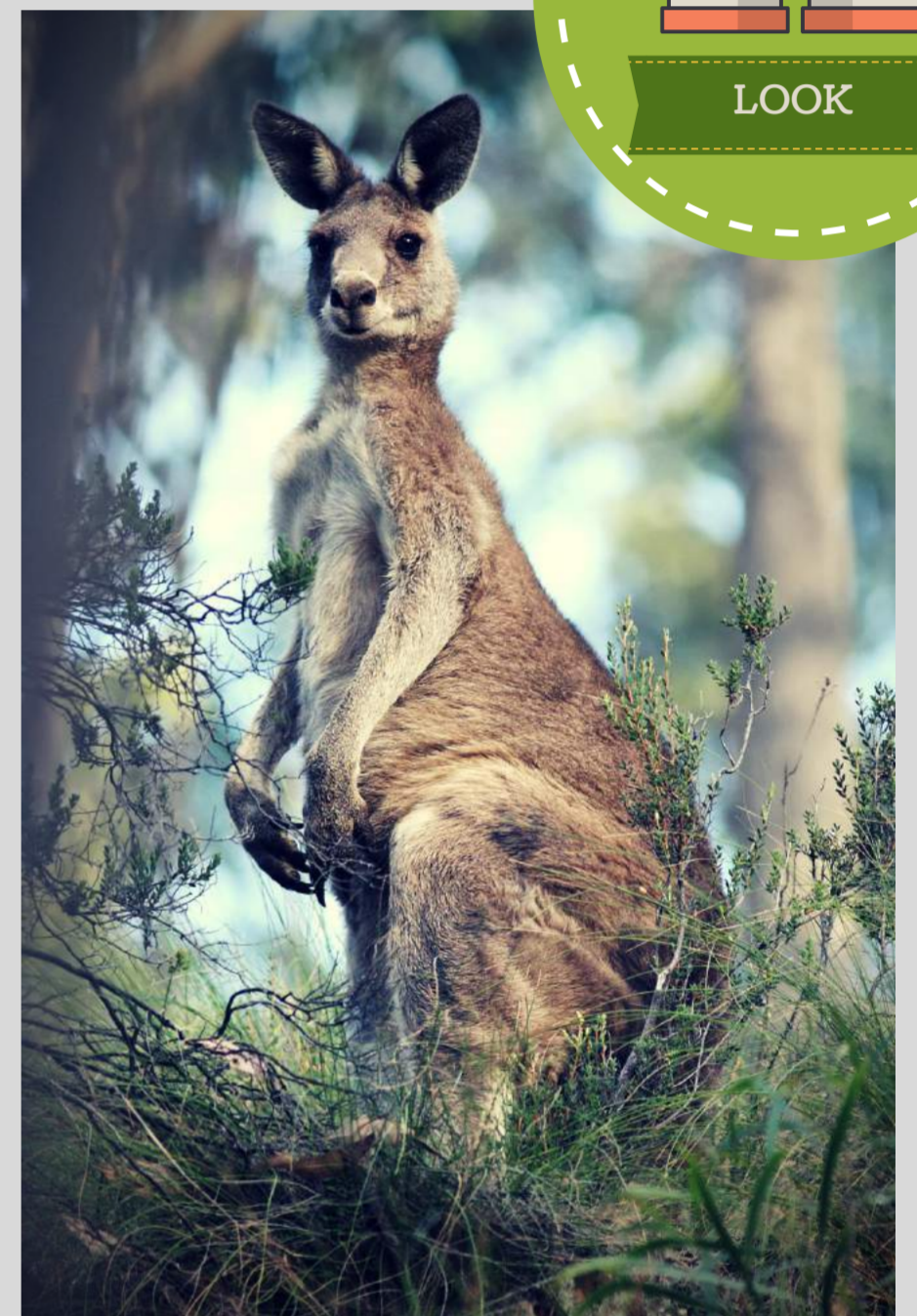

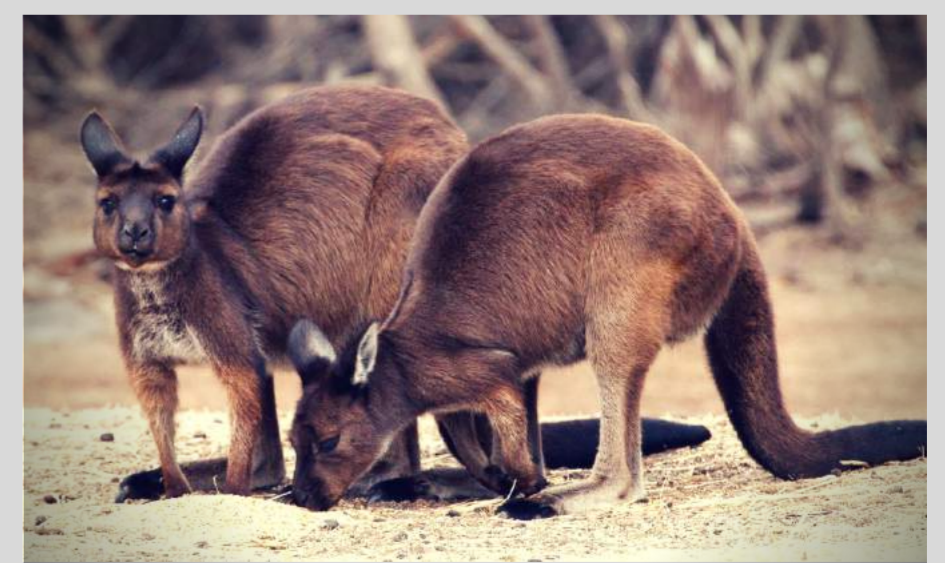
