




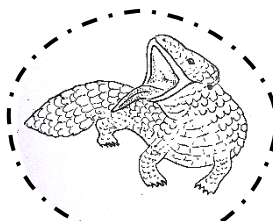
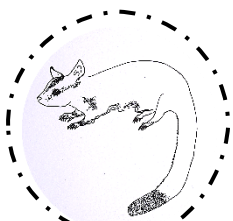
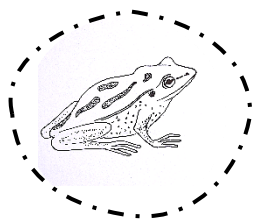


HABITATS

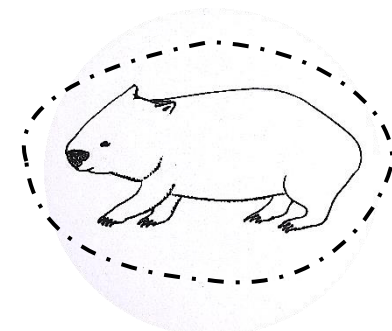

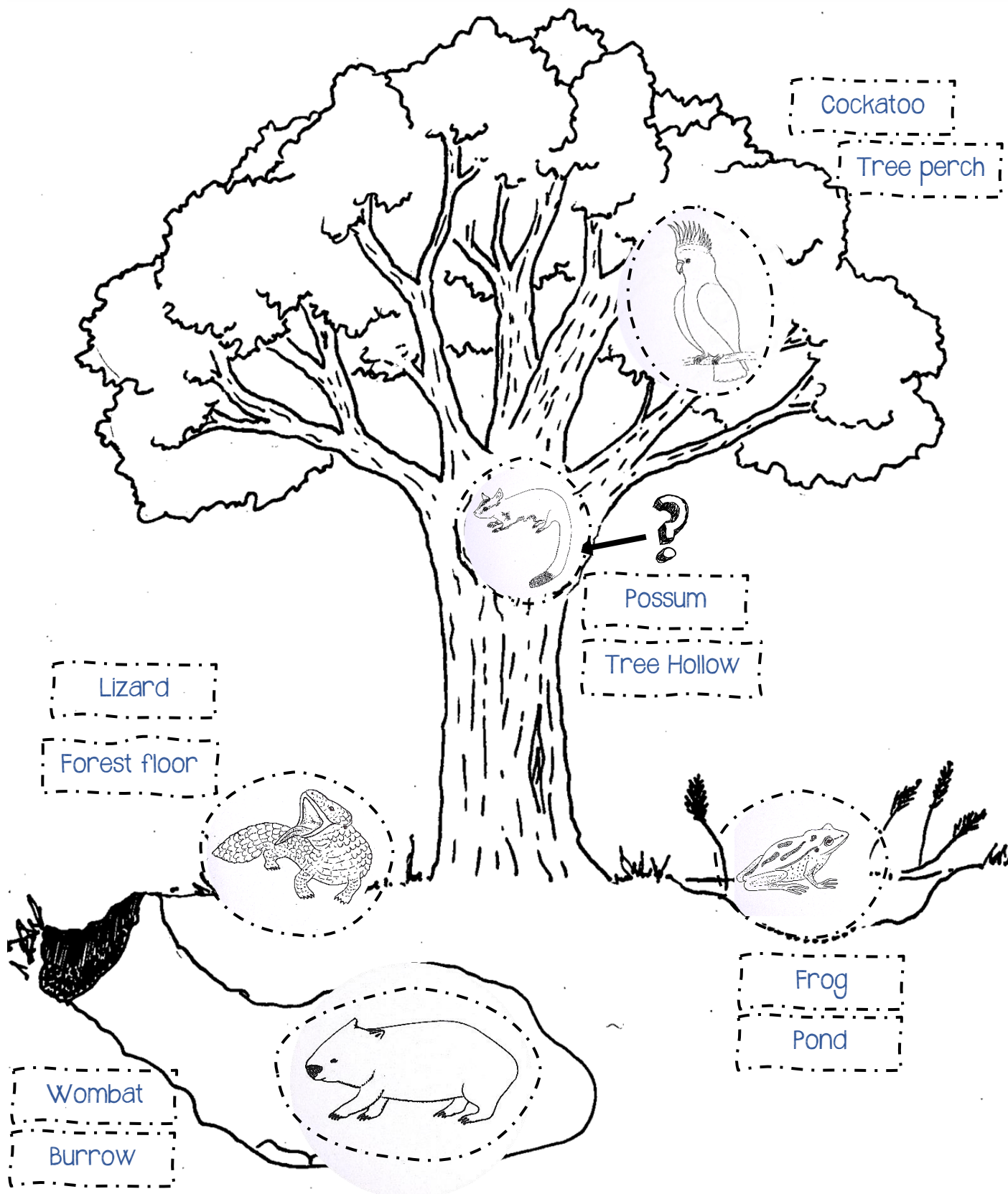
