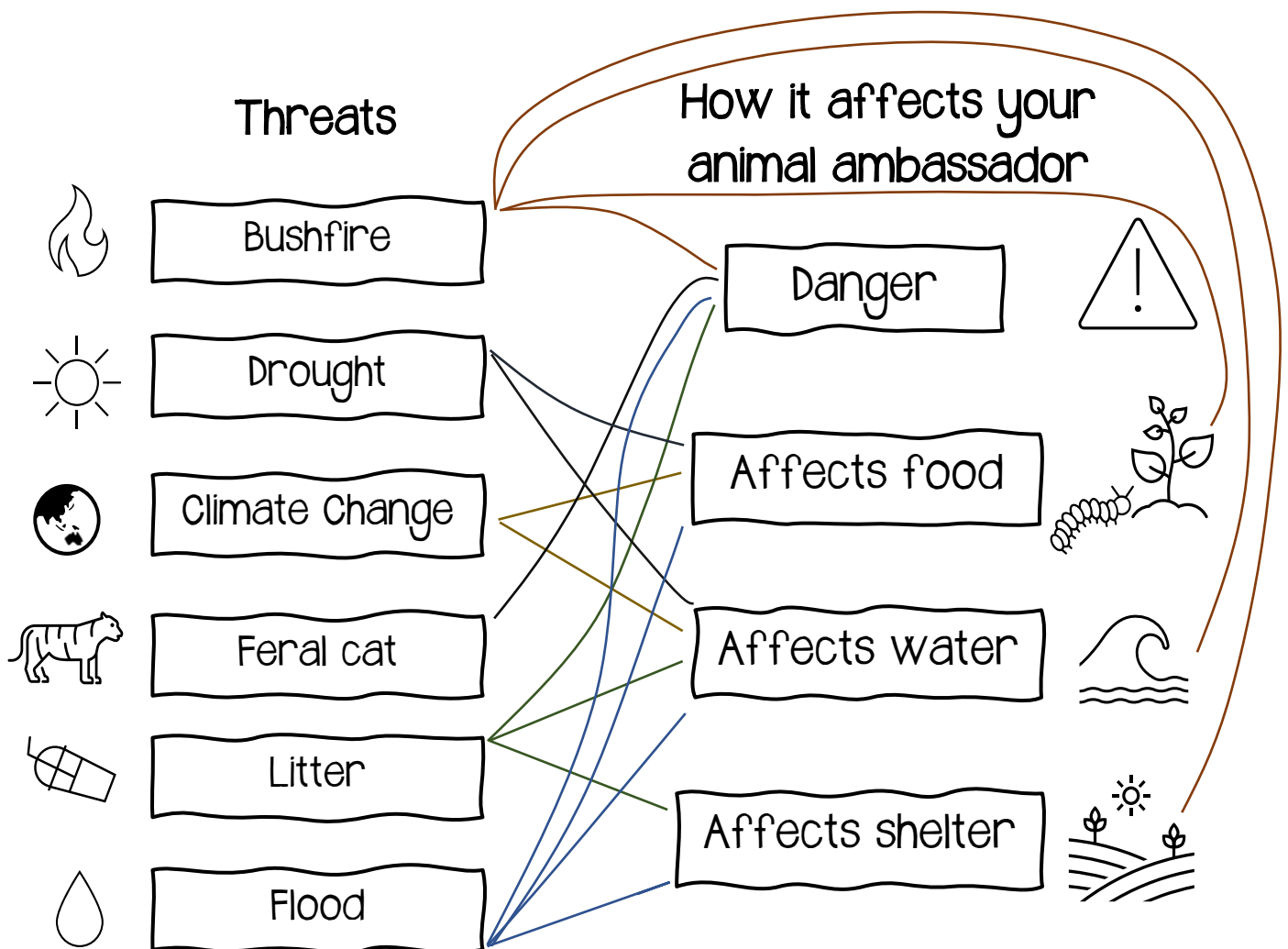


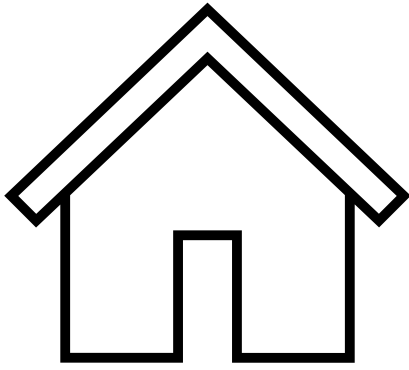
THREATS AND ACTIONS

A threat is something makes it harder for an animal to live. Some threats may put an animal in danger (such as a predator). But they also might have threats to their food, water, or shelter (homes).

Use items again in new ways or buy second hand



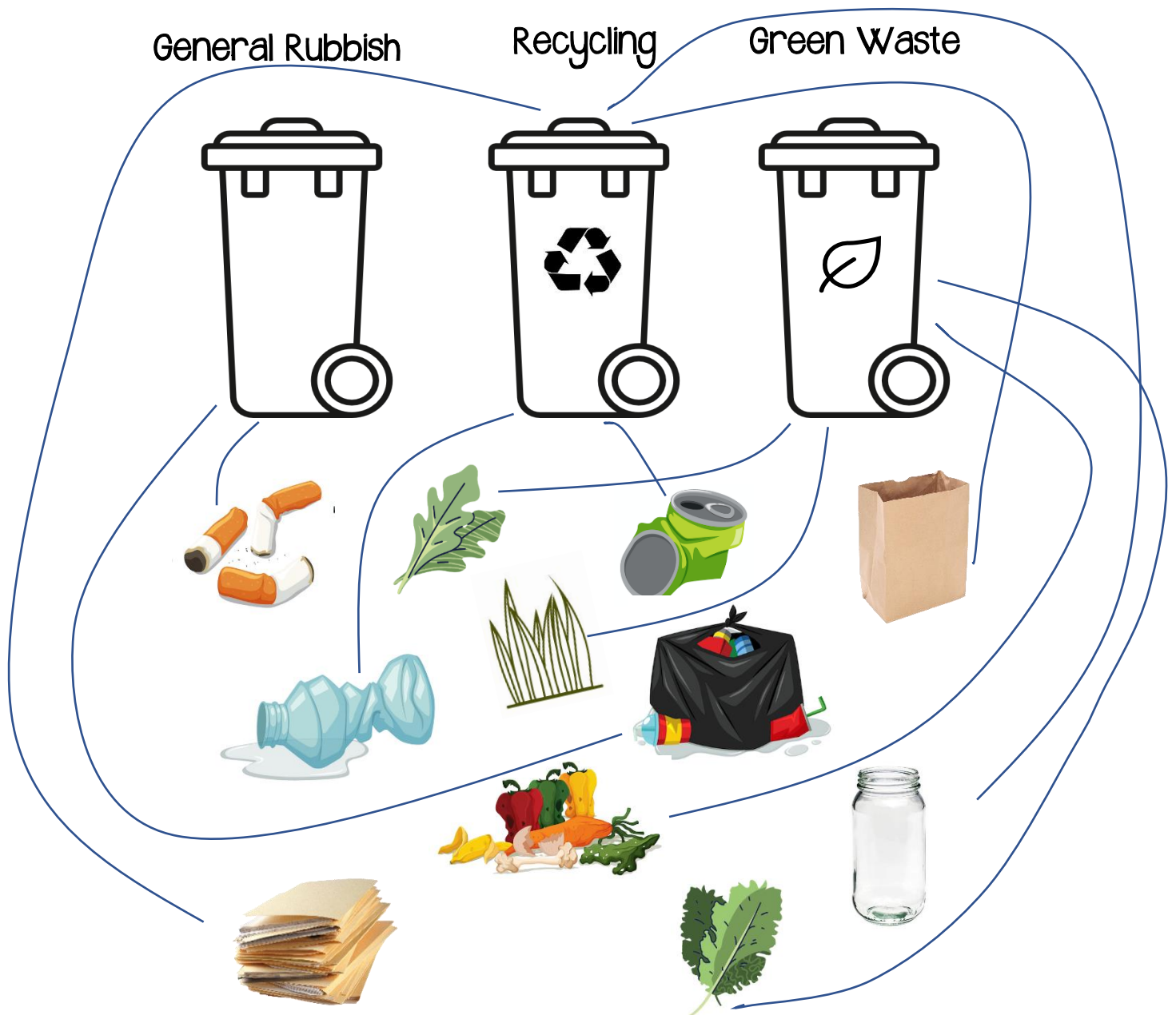
Recycle
