

# COVID Safe Excursions

*December 2021*

Moonlit Sanctuary is following our COVID Safe plan in accordance with Victorian Government regulations. We are endeavouring to keep our staff and all our visitors safe with the following measures.

We appreciate the cooperation of schools to ensure we can abide by these regulations.

## **School responsibilities:**

### **Proof of Vaccination**

All visitors 18 years of age and over, will be required to provide proof of full vaccination before entering Moonlit Sanctuary, except where exempt, as per the Victorian Government directions

### **Contact Tracing**

A Department of Education and Training [Excursion attendance form for contact tracing](#) must be provided prior to entry. This should be submitted to [education@moonlitsanctuary.com](mailto:education@moonlitsanctuary.com) at least 24 hours prior to your excursion date.

### **Social Distancing**

Teachers and school supervisors are responsible for ensuring students follow safe physical distancing measures with other visitors during their time in the park.

### **Masks**

Masks are recommended where 1.5 metres of physical distancing cannot be maintained, as per the current Department of Health guidelines.

# **Moonlit Sanctuary responsibilities:**

## **Social Distancing**

Our Zoo Educators will make every effort to support school staff in managing social distancing between school groups during education sessions.

Our team will also ensure education sessions and breaks do not take place in the same zones at the same time at another school group.

## **Masks**

All Moonlit Sanctuary staff will wear masks when social distancing cannot be maintained.

## **Cleansing**

Education Zone surfaces are sanitised in between use by different schools (daily). Hand sanitiser will be provided upon entry into to Moonlit Sanctuary
