
Position Purpose

Facilities & Maintenance

- Maintain buildings, exhibits, infrastructure, equipment and grounds as per Maintenance Schedules.
- Carry out regular maintenance inspections of Moonlit Sanctuary grounds, habitats and safety equipment as directed and report any maintenance required.
- Maintain all plant and machinery as per the Maintenance Schedules.
- Maintain and service Moonlit Sanctuary's vehicles as per the Maintenance Schedules.
- Work in alignment with Moonlit Sanctuary's waste disposal strategies.

Projects & Improvement Works

Carry out improvement works as directed, ensuring safety of self, employees and visitors.

Work, Health and Safety

- Demonstrate work, health and safety leadership and commitment to working toward a zeroharm workplace.
- Actively model behaviours that enhance Moonlit Sanctuary's safety culture.
